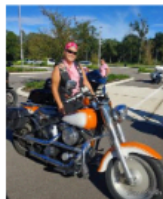
For the women of the Gypsy Chapter of the Diva Angels, sisterhood has become something we experience, not simply something we call ourselves. We may have different
